

 Use Integrated Pest Management. If contracting with a pest control operator, specify in contracts the use of IPM at your facility. IPM-certified pest management providers can be found at EcoWiseCertified.com, GreenShieldCertified.org, or WhatIsGreenPro.org.

 Minimize the use of disinfectants to only surfaces in restrooms or on door handles. When necessary, use a hydrogen peroxide based disinfecting product with an automatic dilution system.

3. Segregate, drain, crush and recycle used oil filters. Crushing extracts another 3-4 oz. of oil per filter for recycling and reduces waste volume and hauling cost. Consider purchasing a crusher for use in-shop.

4. No chlorinated cleaners or petroleum distillates are used.

5. Use only zinc-free flux and lead-free solder for radiator maintenance.
